Venues

THE RESTAURANT & BAR

The bar & restaurant are an ideal venue for hosting groups up to 80 guests. This rental includes exclusive use of our two dining rooms, each with a river stone fireplace, as well as the bar and cafe, which includes an ocean-view sun porch, a wrap-around veranda and a sitting room and bar. The complete property is reserved exclusively for you and your guests, and you can continue your party with music until 12 a.m. For smaller events, you may also rent one of the dining rooms for a formal seated dinner. *See our Events pdf for details.*

RECEPTION TENT ON THE LAWN

The MacCallum House white tent can accommodate up to 200 guests. The rock wall gardens and the charming landscaped grounds are incorporated into the tent decor. The tent is elegantly decorated and includes a dance floor and beautifully set tables for dining. Amplified music is only allowed in the tent until 10 p.m. After ten, we offer private use of the restaurant and bar for cocktails and socializing or for more dancing, so your festivities can continue inside until 12 a.m.



Planning and Coordination

Our in-house coordinator will be your main point-of-contact throughout the planning process and on-site the day of your wedding. She will coordinate all venue-related details including your event timeline, recommendation of outside vendors such as photographers, florists, DJs, etc., as well as provide direction and oversight of the wedding, day-of.

Planning services include a dedicated coordination and menu planning meeting with both our in-house coordinator and Executive Chef to create your perfect, seasonal menu paired with local wines and spirits. Our Reservations Manager at the hotel will take care of all room-related details including establishing your guest-room block, assigning rooms and monitoring the status of room reservations.

We also provide custom printing services for menus, place cards and table numbers.
