The coordinator is responsible for the development and execution of the event timeline. They are available via phone or e-mail throughout the planning process and onsite on the wedding day. The planning services include a meeting with the executive chef to create a custom menu paired with wines. For weddings held on the east lawn in the tent, the wedding party will also have a meeting with a technical director to select a color scheme, decorations, lighting and tent layout. Included is a custom printed menu for each guest at the reception.
